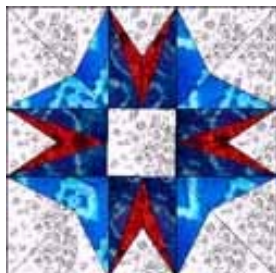
Grab a Brown Bag...Some fabric and come have some fun!!!!

It is time to start another Brown Bag club. This year, we are doing things a little different. The new Brown Bag club will meet either on the first Wed of each month at 1:00 pm, or the first Thur. evening at 6:00 pm.

Each person will bring a bag with between 5-6 yards of fabric that they want their quilt made from.

At the meeting, a quilt block will be demonstrated. Then everyone will switch sacks. You take the sack home that you got and make one quilt block 12 1/2" x 12 1/2". Put the block in the sack and bring it the next month.

We continue this for 12 months. At the last meeting, you get your sack back with 12 blocks ready to be assembled. The cost for the Brown Bag club will be \$3 a month or \$36 for the total year. This covers the pattern and instruction.

Class Schedule

Feb. 4th, 18th, Mar. 3rd & 17th: Beginners 101 – 6:00pm to 8:00pm Cost: \$20

The quilt we will do is called Flower Garden. The pattern came from Holloway Quilts, in Gatlinburg, TN. It is great for a beginner and requires 12 fat quarters. The fat quarters need to be 6 light and 6 dark. There is a supply list that will need to be purchased in advance. This class will meet every other Monday. Pre-registration is required.



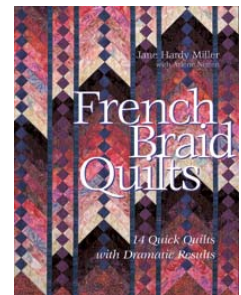
Feb. 5th, 19th, & 26th: Contra Dance – 1:00pm-3:00pm Cost \$20

Contra Dance has three simple blocks: a square 8", 10" or 12", a 4-patch made with 4", 5" or 6" squares and a block with 2 smaller 4-patches and 2 plain patches. All the blocks are set as straight rows. The quilt is then cut and resewn into an on-point setting. There are NO diagonal rows of different sizes, NO setting triangles and NO corner blocks. This technique makes On-Point sets a snap! Contra Dance is especially good when you want to feature a large or medium-large scale print.



Feb. 7th, 21st, 28th, Mar. 13th & 20th: French Braid 1:00 pm or 6:00 pm Cost \$30

These quilts are extremely forgiving, with a high tolerance for minor errors and personal differences in seam allowances, and the results are dramatic, whether your fabric selection tends toward calm and peaceful or knockout. French braids also give you a lot of quilt for your sewing time.



Feb. 23rd: Strippers Club – 10:30am to 1:00pm Cost: \$5

This club meets every other month. During the club, we meet and go over new patterns that have come out for Jelly Rolls. After a brief discussion, and show and tell from the last club, it is open sew. This allows club members to work on the Jelly Roll pattern of their choice.
