# March Class Schedule

## **Brown Bag Club \$3 per month –**

**Either Wed. Mar. 5<sup>th</sup> at 1:00pm or Thurs. Mar. 6<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 pm**

This is our new club for the year. Each person will bring a “bag” with 5-6 yards of fabric that they want a quilt made into. At the club, a block of the month will be demonstrated. Then everyone will switch bags and go and make a 12 ½” x 12 ½” block out of the fabric in the sack they received. Then put the block and extra fabric back in the sack and return it next month. At each meeting we will switch bags. At the end of 12 months, you have enough blocks to make a quilt.



## **Sat. March 8<sup>th</sup>: 1:00 pm – Dakota Collectibles Embroidery Club** **\$45 per quarter or \$175 per year**

This club will provide you with the following items each quarter: 20 designs, at least 7 fun-filled projects, \$5 off coupon good on one design pack in the store and a coupon (valued up to \$50) for 2 free downloadable designs from the Dakota Collectibles website. ## **Chuck Full O’Charms - \$15**

**Tues. Mar. 4<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 pm OR**

**Sat. Mar. 15<sup>th</sup> 10:30am – 3:30pm (bring a sack lunch)**

Use charm packs or cut your own 5” squares from scraps, fat quarters or fat eights to make this easy quilt. The charm squares are set as straight rows. The quilt is then cut and resewn into an on-point setting. There are NO diagonal rows of different sizes, NO setting triangles and NO corner blocks. This technique makes On-Point sets a snap.



## **Barn Dance - \$15**

**Tues. Mar. 18<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 pm OR**

**Sat. Mar. 22<sup>nd</sup> 10:30am – 3:30pm (bring a sack lunch)**

Simple one-patch blocks make Barn Dance very easy to sew. Barn Dance uses 4 light and 4 dark fabrics for the baby size or 6 light and 6 dark fabrics for the larger sizes. Another option is to use your scraps for Barn Dance. Just make sure all the darks are similar in value and color and all the lights are similar in color and value. Or just pick up a bunch of fat quarters from a fabric collection that has lots of fabrics.



**Thurs. March 13<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup>: French Braid – 6:00pm**

These are the final two classes to finish up this great project that was started in February. These projects are going to be gorgeous.

**Thurs. March 13<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup>: 1:00pm – 3:00pm – Just For You - \$20**

Ribbet, ribbet! No one can look at this happy fellow without smiling. Our appliquéd frog matches the border design in this little quilt, which can double as a crib accessory or wall hanging.

Skill Level: Intermediate
